Michael Davern is the CEO and General Manager of Ireland's top internationally acclaimed hotel and resort; The K Club. A native of Cashel, Co Tipperary, Michael graduated from Shannon College of Hotel Management in 1988. He commenced his career with Trust House Forte in the UK with assistant management positions at Sheffield and later in the new Forte Hotel in Hull whilst also working as a project manager with a software development company engaged in the catering business.

In 1991, Michael joined the opening team of the K Club which became the first property in Ireland to achieve the coveted AA Five Stars where he was later appointed Deputy General Manager for Food and Beverage. To gain further experience

in the international hotel industry, Michael moved to the Fancourt Hotel and Country Club on the Garden Route in South Africa and became General Manager at the age of just 29.

Four years later, Michael became General Manager of the exclusive Sandy Lane Properties in Barbados, where he was involved in the development of many projects including two new golf courses, club house and a real estate project. In 2005, Michael returned to the K Club as CEO and General Manager, no doubt his greatest achievement was steering the K Club along with his team, through the 2006 Ryder Cup.

Michael is married to Aideen and has two children; Ava and Emer. Two of Michael's brothers are also graduates of Shannon College; Donagh is General Manager of the Heritage Hotel, Killenard and Bryan is General Manager of the former Berkley Court Hotel in Ballsbridge, currently D4 Hotels.
